11-20-18 Burglary-Vehicle 2200 Blk Rocky Point Place
Sometime prior to 4:24 PM, unknown suspect(s) enter victim's unsecured vehicle, remove debit and credit cards and later make at least one fraudulent purchase.

Sometime between 9:10 AM and 10:31 PM, unknown suspect(s) enter through a closed/unlocked side gate and enter the rear yard. Suspect(s) enter the residence through an open/unlocked kitchen door, then ransack the residence removing currency.
